



## Online booking for COVID-19 testing now available

January 14<sup>th</sup>, 2021 - People experiencing COVID-19 symptoms can now register online to book an appointment at Norfolk General Hospital's (NGH) COVID-19 Assessment Centre.

The Assessment Centre's online e-booking platform went live on Thursday, January 14th.

The testing criteria include people who have:

- COVID-19 symptoms.
- Exposure to a confirmed case of COVID-19 within the last 5-7 days
- Live or work in an at-risk setting (long-term care home, homeless shelter, etc)
- Essential caregiver for a resident in a long-term care or retirement home
- Needing clearance for pre-surgical or pre-procedural appointments

Appointments are available on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday, and Saturdays from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

All appointments booked through the portal or by phone will take place at NGH's COVID-19 Assessment Centre located at the Robinson Street entrance in Simcoe, ON.

People requiring a COVID-19 swab who meet the Ministry of Health criteria can also call the NGH Assessment Centre at 519-426-0130 Ext. 2234
