

Screening Entrances Norfolk General Hospital

Effective **Tuesday, January 5th, 2021**

As the COVID-19 pandemic continues to evolve, the safety of our patients, families, and staff remains paramount. For everyone's safety, the Norfolk General Hospital is limiting hospital access and screening all patients and visitors entering the facilities. Anyone requiring entry to the hospital must enter the West Street Public Screening Entrance. It will be open to the public from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday to Friday. It will be closed on weekends.

If you need to enter the hospital outside of those hours or on Saturday or Sunday, patients and families will be screened at the Emergency Department Entrance.

NGH staff will ask patients and visitors about symptoms, particularly respiratory symptoms, and contact with others.
