### **Young Entrepreneur supports YOC 2.0**

11 year old Lexi Miller-Cluckie donated \$100 to the Norfolk General Hospital Foundation Year of the Cat 2.0 Campaign. The money was raised over a 3 month period from Lexi's summer business Da'Bomb Bath Products.

The Grade 6 Lakewood Elementary student was one of 10 students to receive a Student Start Up Program (SSUP) grant from Norfolk County to start a business. Lexi's entrepreneurial adventure did quite well this past summer. She made and sold scrunchies, bath bombs, soap, sugar scrubs, lavender sachets and jewellery, at markets in Norfolk. She told customers of her intention to donate to NGH upon completion of the program with 10 percent of profits from the sale of each scrunchy going to NGH.

Lexi told the Foundation that she wants to help kids with cancer. Her donation will support the new CT at NGH which can be used to detect a variety of conditions including cancer.
