The Norfolk General Hospital Foundation Golf Classic Silver Anniversary was a record breaker raising \$335,000 towards the revitalization of the NGH Labour & Delivery Unit.

For our 26th year, we have a new focus. The 2015 Classic is scheduled for July 20-22 rain or shine at the beautiful and historic Norfolk Golf and Country Club. The generous support of players and sponsors will help fund the purchase of new state-of-the-art hospital beds. The goal: \$150,000! These beds will contribute greatly to the patient experience offering better mobility, safety and comfort.

This small, rural hospital golf tournament has been an incredible success since its modest beginning in 1990. Over the years, the tournament has contributed to the Family Fund, The Year of the Cat CT Scan Campaign and helped purchase items such as patient lifts and Operating Room upgrades. To date, over \$1.8 million has been contributed to the NGH Foundation making the Classic one of the largest fundraising golf tournaments per capita in Ontario.

Members of the county's rich agricultural, business and industrial bases will come together again for 2015, with the Foundation and a dedicated group of tournament volunteers to raise much needed funds to support the purchase of new beds for NGH.

"I have been very proud to be involved in this tournament now into 26 years as both a player and co-chair. Last year was a big year, but so is ever year. This is our community hospital and I know Norfolk County will continue to lend its support when asked." says Dr. Jeff Greenfield, Co-Chair.
