Outpatient clinics and services are open

Norfolk General Hospital continues to safely ramp up our Clinics and Surgical Procedures affected by the COVID 19 pandemic. Clinics and programs including the Ontario Breast Screening Program (OBSP), Diabetes Education, Feet First Program and surgical procedures have resumed. Our Emergency Department continues to be open 24/7.
