The Simcoe Lions Club delivered two donations in support of better healthcare in Norfolk. The two cheques totaling \$25,000 were presented Tuesday, August 1 to the Norfolk General Hospital Foundation. As presenting sponsors of the 2017 Foundation Golf Classic held in July, the club contributed \$10,000 to the purchase of new hospital beds and emergency room stretchers. The club has also committed to supporting the Building a Better Hospital Campaign with a \$15,000 installment going toward their five year commitment of \$75,000.

"I cannot say enough about how grateful this hospital is to the Simcoe Lions Club. It is encouraging to have the continued support of those who share in our vision of what an exceptional healthcare experience should be" said Kelly Isfan upon accepting the donations.

The Lions contribution to the Golf Classic will assist NGH with the purchase of 20 new beds and 16 new stretchers completing the replacement of old equipment and enhancing the comfort and safety of patients. The \$13 million Building a Better Hospital Campaign will replace the Surgical Day Care unit, rebuild Labour and Delivery and renovate a Minimally Invasive Operating Room.
