NGH in conjunction with the Haldimand Norfolk Health Unit have declared the outbreak over. No new cases have been identified and visitor restrictions have been lifted on 4B.

NGH would like to recognize the swift and accurate work of the staff implementing Outbreak control measures especially in the area of enhanced hand hygiene practice and environmental cleaning and disinfection.
