"This is a vitally important piece of equipment that provides a safe and stable environment especially for premature births. Thanks to the 100 Women Who Care, we can maintain the highest level of care to vulnerable newborns at NGH" commented Heather Riddell.

"We were made aware that the hospital only has one, very aged incubator. Purchasing the new unit gives families added confidence and enhances our local capabilities" stated Sue Goble. "NGH employs excellent professionals and facilities to support our young families and we know this investment will be appreciated by both staff and patients."

The new incubator was on the list of several pieces of equipment to be purchased during May's "Delivering our Future" Radiothon a day long broadcast with local radio station 98.9 myFM.

Since May 2014, 100 Women Who Care Norfolk has donated over \$280,000 to 18 local charities.
