Norfolk Mutual Insurance fulfilled their \$80,000.00 donation commitment to the Norfolk General Hospital Foundation today, one year earlier than promised. Back in 2014, Norfolk Mutual responded to the Norfolk General Hospital's "Building A Better Hospital" Campaign, promising \$80,000.00 total by the end of 2019 towards much needed equipment and facilities updates for the hospital.

Norfolk General Hospital Foundation Director, Jennifer White, was on site to receive the symbolic cheque at the Norfolk Mutual's annual Open House. "Through the support of donors like Norfolk Mutual, we are thrilled to have reached the \$10 million mark." The Building a Better Hospital Campaign is ongoing, with \$3 Million left before their contribution goal is met. Norfolk Mutual's new President and CEO, Gary Anderson is delighted that the hospital will have access to the funds earlier than promised, "The Norfolk General Hospital is our community's home base for healthcare. As we reflect on 137 years of business in Norfolk County, we can look back on the company's legacy and see Norfolk General Hospital; an integral part of our history of community support." In July this year, Policyholders of both Norfolk Mutual Insurance Company and Wabisa Mutual Insurance Company (Jarvis, ON) voted in favour of the amalgamation of the two companies. As of January 1, 2019, the amalgamated company will be called Nova Mutual. "Nova Mutual looks forward to continuing to support local charities such as the NGH Foundation in the future." added Gary Anderson.
