Norfolk General Hospital wants you to be aware that access to the Robinson Street entrance and parking will be a somewhat challenging over the next few weeks. Sewer, water main and roadway reconstruction on Robinson St. at Queen St. in Simcoe has caused a closure on Queen St. from West St. to Marshall Ave. Norfolk County Roads Department has posted signage of the closure and clearly marked the detour route around the work site. The work should wrap up on Friday June 26. In the meantime, NGH would like to make patients and visitors to the hospital aware that this closure will cause delayed access to our Main Entrance and parking and in some cases to our Emergency and Diagnostic Imaging Departments. NGH and Norfolk County appreciate your patience and cooperation as this work is completed.
