Norfolk General Hospital and West Haldimand General Hospital To Share a Single Leadership Team

Beginning April 1, 2015 West Haldimand General Hospital (WHGH) and Norfolk General Hospital (NGH) have agreed in principle to begin a process in to phase in the sharing of a single leadership team. The two communities served by these hospitals have been connected by care with a strong physician partnership including a shared surgical program and a number of medical specialists for over 30 years and are looking to strengthen that partnership.

“I am very pleased to announce that Kelly Isfan, President and CEO of the Norfolk General Hospital will assume the role of President and CEO of the West Haldimand General Hospital beginning April 1, 2015”, stated Patty Nixon, Chair of the WHGH Board of Directors. Ms. Isfan will concurrently lead the two corporations and be accountable to each hospital’s Board of Directors. The two hospitals will remain as separate organizations but will work toward sharing additional leadership staff in order to direct the most resources toward quality patient care.

Beth Snowden Norfolk General Hospital Board of Directors Chair underlined Ms. Nixon’s statement by saying “On behalf of the NGH Board, we welcome this opportunity for NGH to partner with West Haldimand General. Together, we will continue to inspire exceptional health care in our shared communities.”

This strengthened partnership and shared management will be invisible to patients – but the benefits will definitely be felt by making the best use of scarce financial resources.

WHGH and NGH will begin the phasing in of a shared Chief of Medical Staff (subject to a formal MAC appointment process), VP/Chief Nursing Executive and Chief Financial Officer, the positions which comprise the remainder of the senior leadership team at both hospitals. It is expected that this will be complete by the fall of 2015.

For small and community hospitals in Ontario, the sharing of administrative, support and clinical staff is very common, a direction which The Hamilton Niagara Haldimand Brant Local Health Integrated Network strongly supports. “The HNHB LHIN applauds Norfolk General Hospital and West Haldimand General Hospital for recognizing the value in working more closely together and sharing key administrative roles. Combining these key management positions not only uses resources wisely, but also ensures quality care for patients through strengthening best practice learnings, and recognizing and sharing expertise across organizations” stated Donna Cripps LHIN CEO.
