Norfolk General Hospital is seeking a Registered Respiratory Therapist. - Initiate aerosol therapy with prescribed medications
- Administer oxygen therapy
- Initiate and monitor patients on ventilator support
- Perform pulmonary function testing

- Attend cardiac and respiratory arrest situations as a member of the Cardiac Arrest Team/CCRT
- Assist in the transfer of patients on ventilator support to other hospitals, as required.
- Initiate and monitor patients on BiPAP

- Order supplies for Respiratory department
- Compile statistics as required.
- Perform arterial blood gases
- Instruct patients in the use of metered dose inhalers and incentive spirometers as required.
